BOOKS, SUPPLIES, STATE TESTS, and TECHNOLOGY FEES / DEADLINE IS AUGUST 5:

- K5-2nd: \$450 per child (includes all curriculum books and labs)
- <u>3rd-8th: \$500 per child</u> (includes laptop rental to be turned in at end of school year. If not turned in by the deadline, a \$175 fee will be charged.)
- 9th-12th: \$525 per child (includes laptop rental to be turned in at end of school year. If not turned in by the deadline, a \$175 fee will be charged.)

Parents must rent the laptop through TLCA for students in grades 3rd-12th as we will be using Ignitia curriculum. (This is an online based curriculum taught by master teachers and teaches the material via a wide scope of learning options. This makes individualized learning a true success as students are able to learn in a variety of ways as well as set their own pace. This ensures the child will actually be learning the material before moving on. This program is user-friendly, and an administrator, teacher, or facilitator will always be available to help and assist in the classroom Monday - Wednesday.)

All fees are *non-refundable except in the case a class is unformed or a student is not accepted. Additional fees may apply during school year.
